Structure

Friends of Fondation de France, Inc.

is an **American 501(c)(3) public charity** (EIN 13-3966503), which since 2000 has enabled American donors to support projects of general interest in France and abroad, while benefiting from the tax deduction in force in the USA.

4 steps

1. Prepare your application, with the support of Fondation de France's international team, for examination and approval by our authorities.
2. Once your project has been validated, your donors make their donations to Friends of Fondation de France, indicating your organization as beneficiary. Friends of Fondation de France issues a tax receipt for the donors in accordance with the US law.
3. Friends of Fondation de France transfers the funds to Fondation de France after deduction of the administrative costs, which transfers in turn to your organization.
4. Within one year of the date of payment of the funds, your organization will be asked to send a report on the use of the funds.

Mission
The Arcanys Early Learning Foundation (AELF), based in the Philippines, is a nonprofit organization dedicated to empowering parents to ensure their children's potential being the crucial early childhood development years. AELF has been an advocate of early math and logic development since 2010, **providing free parent-child math coaching to Filipino families**. This maternal-infantile, playful yet fundamental instruction for the entire child's experience of development, has opened opportunities to learn through math.

Actions
As a Civil Society organization, AELF's education is not a priority. The priority is to raise money to fund their needs. To date, their resources, including design, production, and travel, are not an independent part of many children's learning lives. This is where Arcanys Early Learning Foundation steps in. AELF focuses on children aged 1-4, introducing early math and logic. AELF's role is to help open doors to English learners to help them achieve their early learning opportunities.

Projects that US Donors Can Support

The Arcanys Early Learning Foundation aims to expand its early education program and reach more low-income families, providing access to early math and logic instruction.
